<u>Training: May 23 & 24, 2025</u>
LHA Training will take place on Friday, May 23 and Saturday, May 24, 2025 from 9:30 a.m 4:30 p.m. This training is mandatory in order to prepare Living History Apprentices for the volunteer work they will be performing. Applicants accepted to the LHA program will need to pay a \$75 training fee prior to the first day of training. *Please note, the Youth Luminary Volunteer Scholarship is available to LHA applicants who are in need of financial assistance.
